


Tech Tips



Aware Tip - The **view bar** in the upper right hand corner gives you different ways to look at the data. Combine these tools with the different templates to find just the right data.





A Glog is created using a very easy to understand, drag and drop interface that is relevant, enjoyable, and scalable for students of all ages and learning styles. A Glog is an interactive visual platform in which users create a "poster or web page" containing multimedia elements including: text, audio, video, images, graphics, drawings, and data.



Quick Tip - Save Multiple Tabs as Favorites in Internet Explorer

Last week, we showed you how to have multiple tabs open in Internet Explorer. Having multiple tabs saves time because you don't have to keep opening up Internet Explorer. Now imagine you've got several related tabs open and you want to save them all to your favorites. Simply click the **Favorites** button, then click the little arrow next to **Add to Favorites...** and then click **Add Current Tabs to Favorites...** Now, name your folder, click **Add** and you're all set! All of your tabs will be saved in one place for easy access later on!
